

Starting BASS in Edge for the first time

(or another browser)

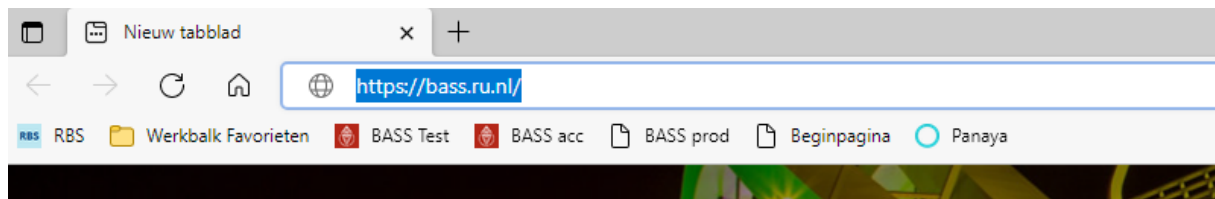
This instruction applies to employees that work in BASS with Oracle forms, e.g. HR-officers, purchasers and finance, after “retirement” of Internet Explorer.

If you follow the instructions below, you will be able to work with Oracle forms in Edge just like you were used to with Internet Explorer.

General

If you do not work on a workplace on campus with a lan (cable) internet connection, you must open the eduvpn connection in order for RU werkplekbeheer (workplace management) to run the necessary scripts. After less than 2 hours the new settings will be active and will you no longer be redirected to IE if you open BASS in Edge.

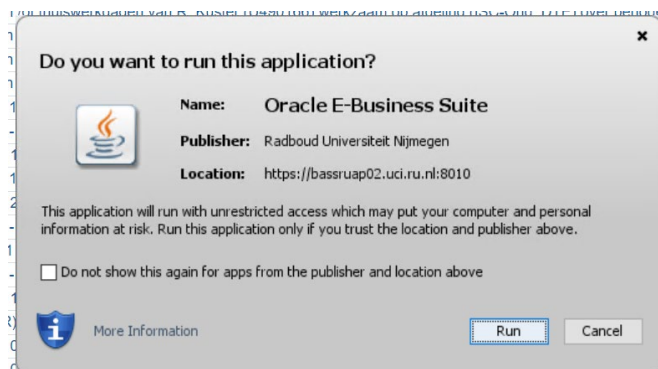
To open BASS, start your browser (Edge) en type in the url bar: <https://bass.ru.nl/>



Tip: save this url with your favorites or save a shortcut on your desktop.

Forms in Edge

As soon as you try to open an Oracle forms screen, you will see this pop-up:



Check the box for: “Do not show this again from the publisher and location above”. Next, click the button [Run]. After that the Oracle form will open. Done

Opening more than one Forms window

Under General Preferences, block Forms Launch is a checkbox “Always Launch New Forms Session” . Check this box to open as many new Forms window in the same browser as needed.

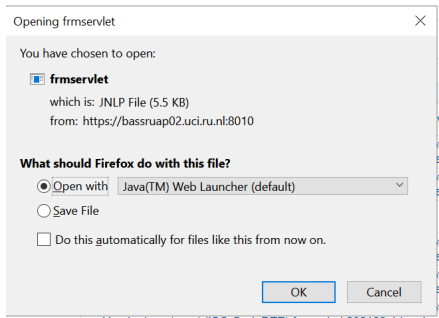

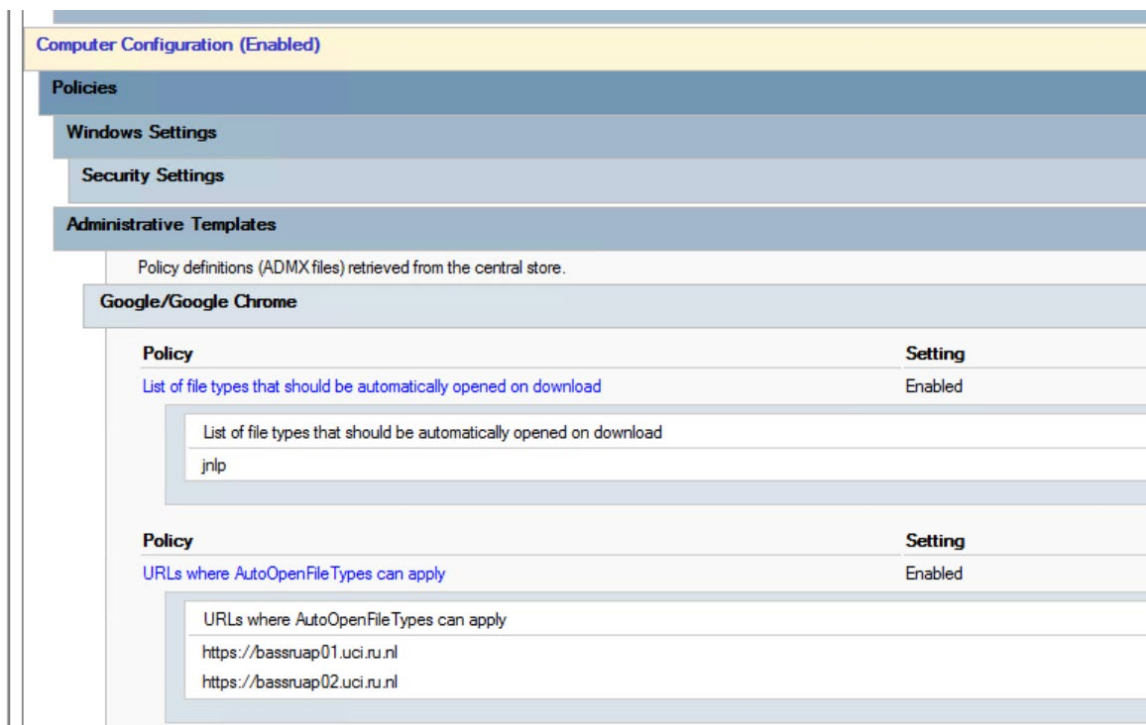
If you use Firefox on a Radboud-workplace, and you try to open an Oracle forms screen, you will see

Enable the policy settings as shown below to prevent warnings and allow automatic opening of the jnlp file.

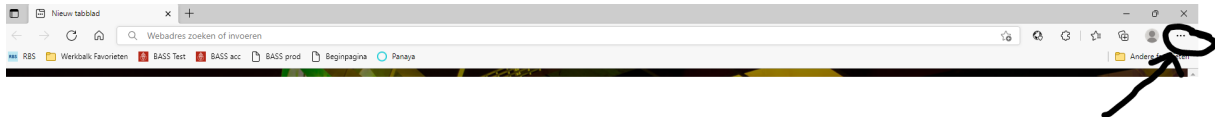


Private computers

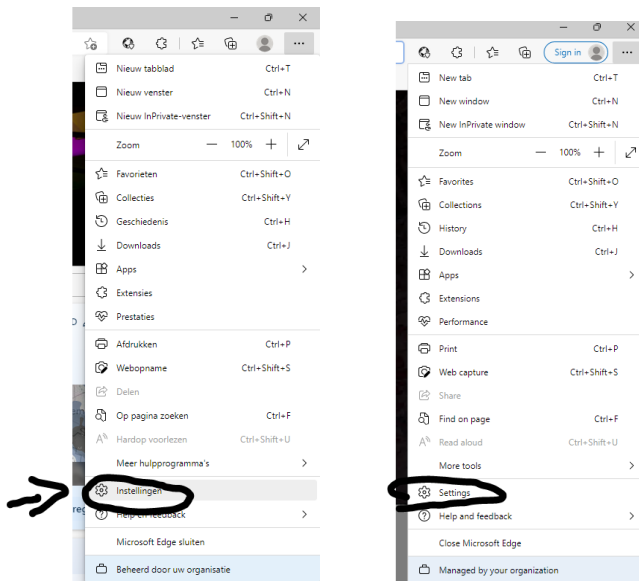
If you use a private computer, Radboud-Werkplekbeheer cannot change settings for you. You have to do the following. (This instruction is for Edge)

Allow all ru.nl sites

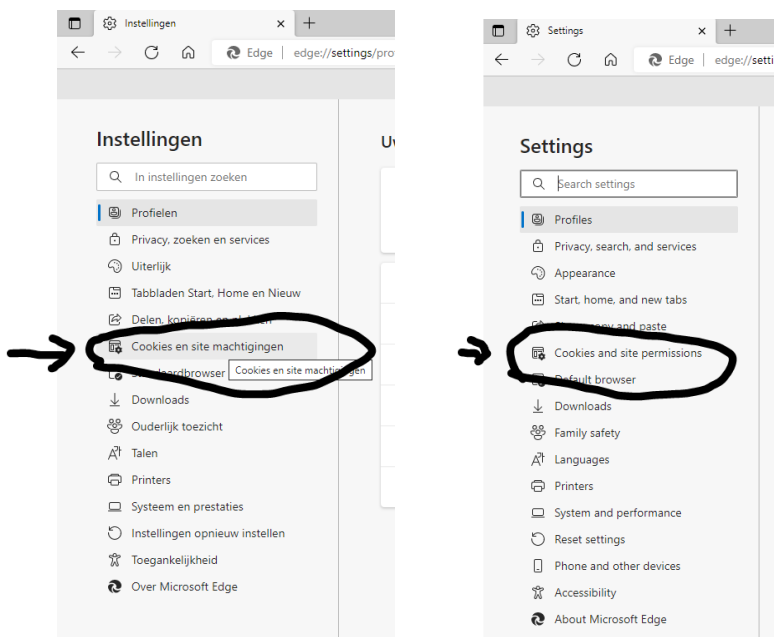
Go to "Settings and more ..."



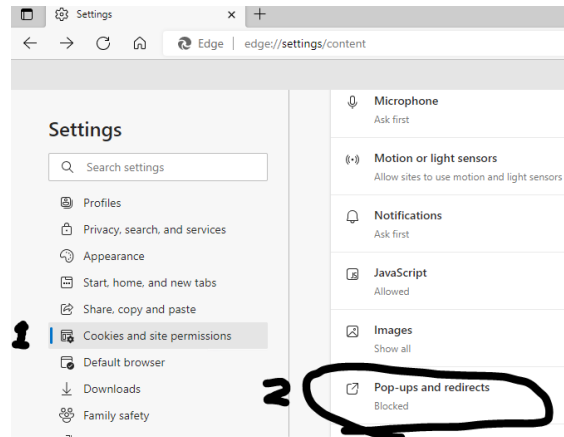
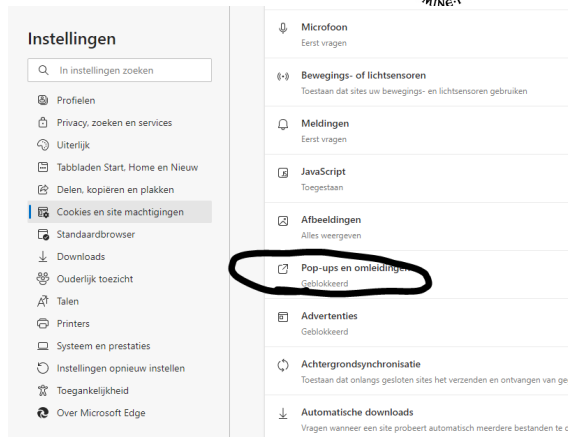
Select "Settings":



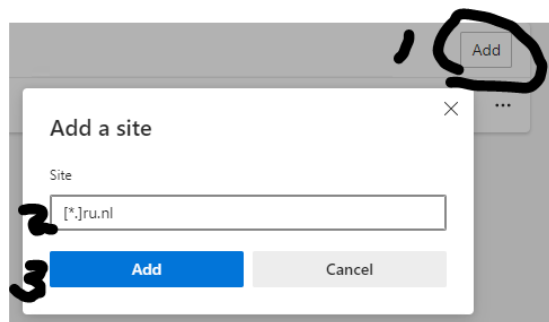
Select Cookies and site permissions



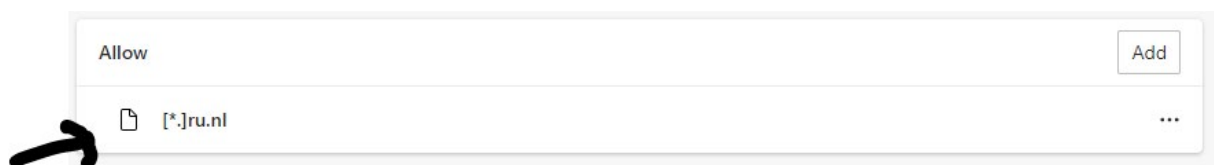
Select "Pop-ups and redirects"



Select Allow, click Add and fill in: `[*.]ru.nl`



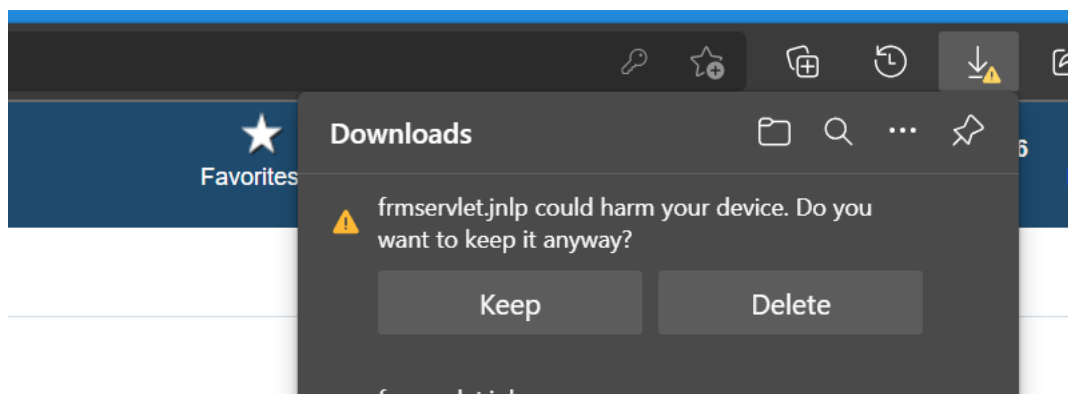

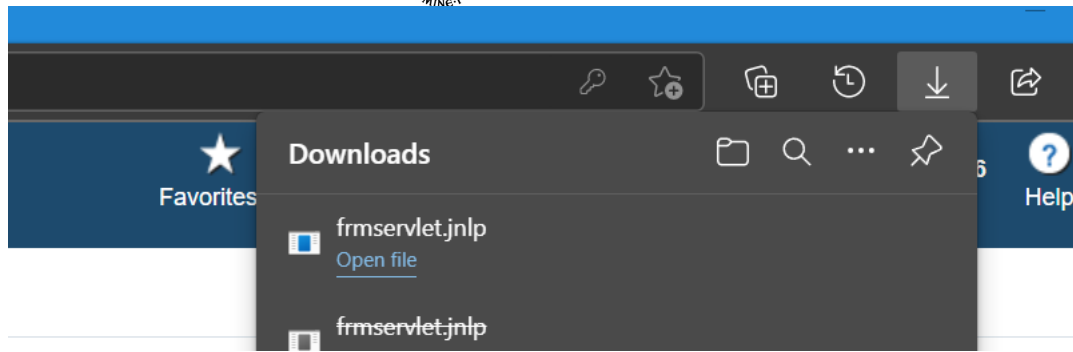
