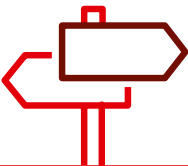

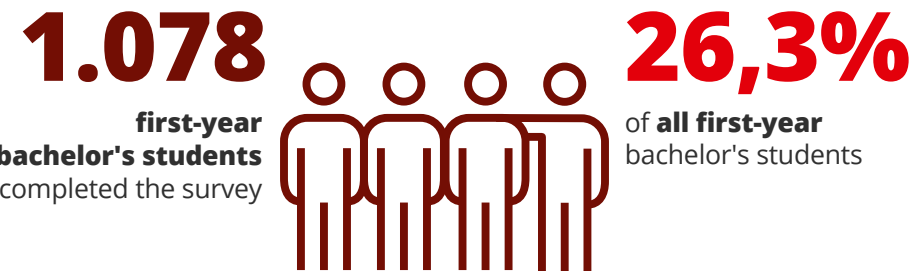
Radboud Welcome Survey 2022

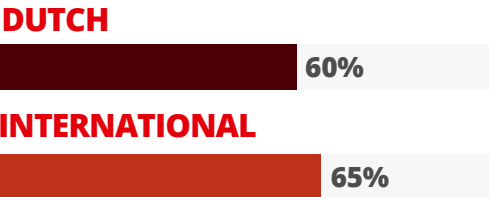

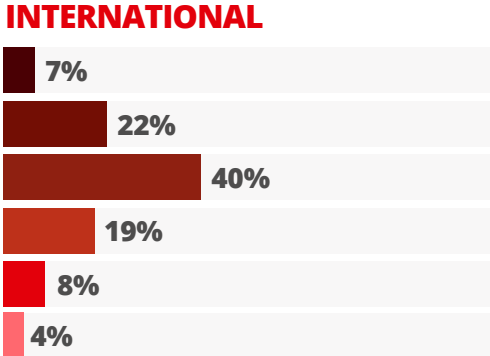
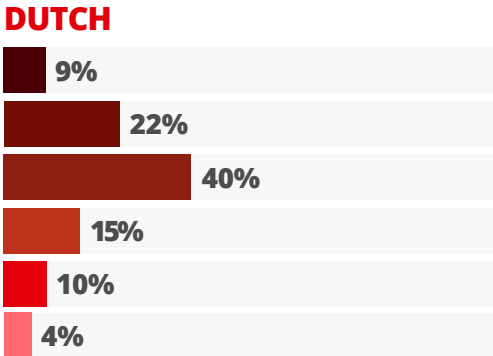

Percentage of students that seriously considered studying at a university **other than** Radboud University

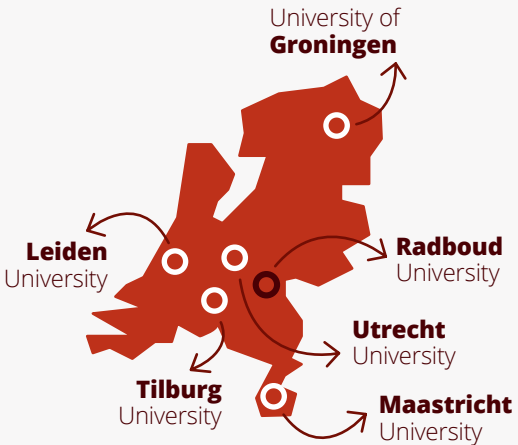
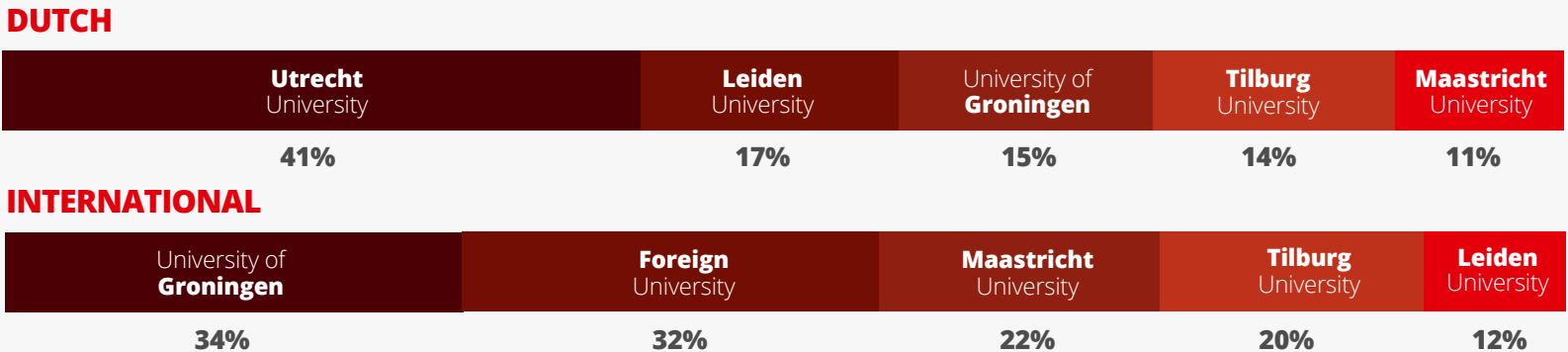

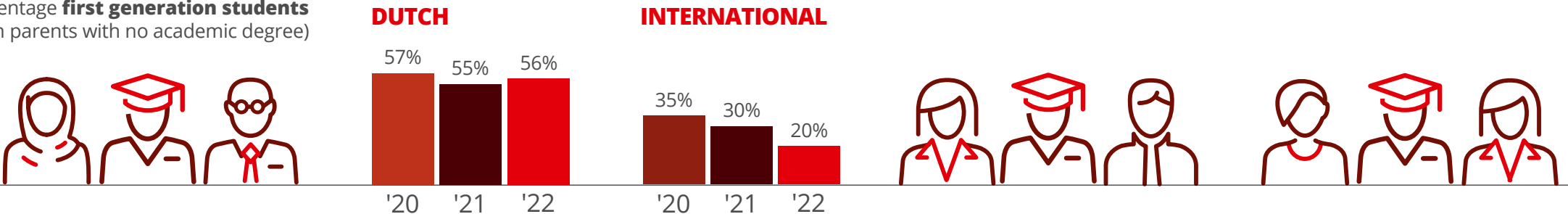


TOP 5 Most frequently considered other universities

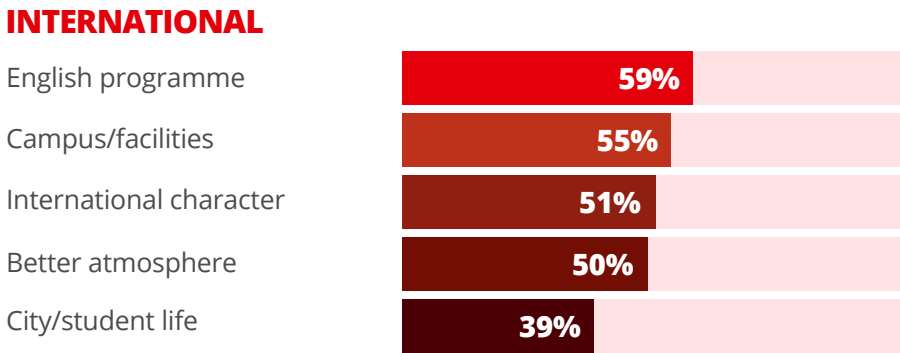
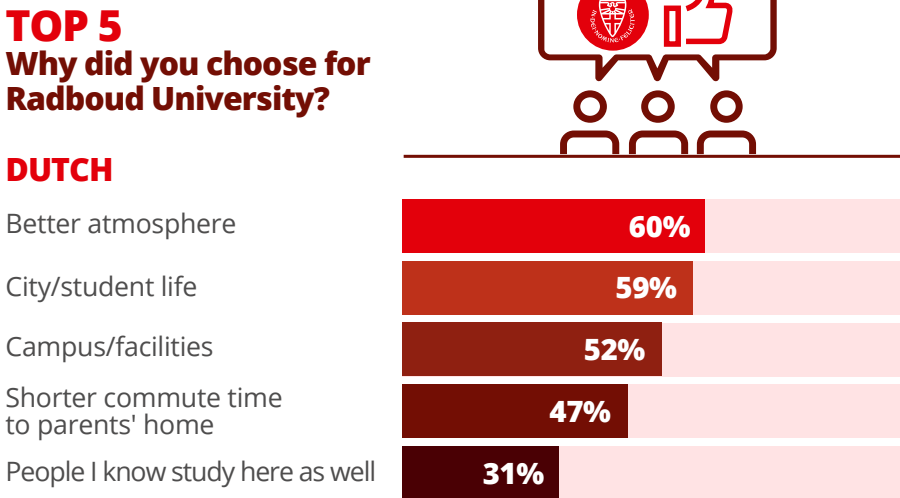
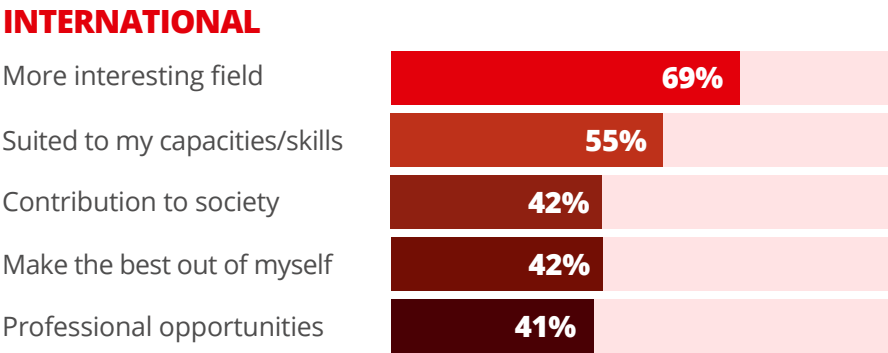
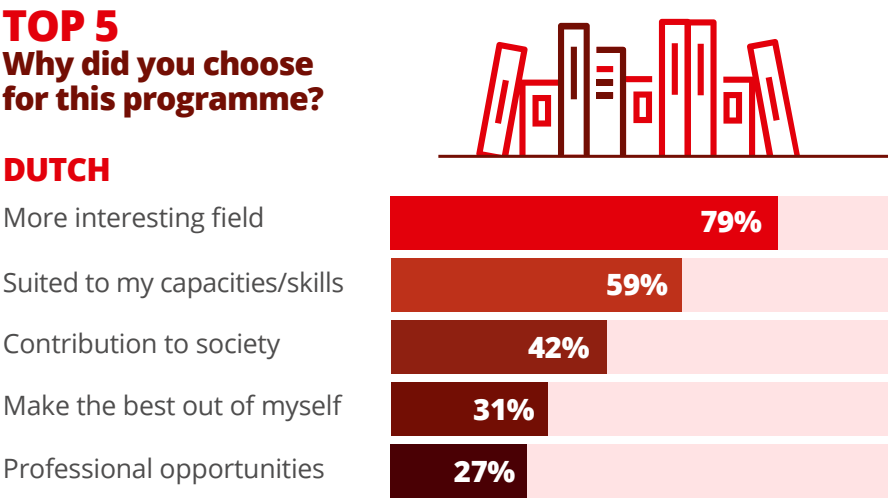
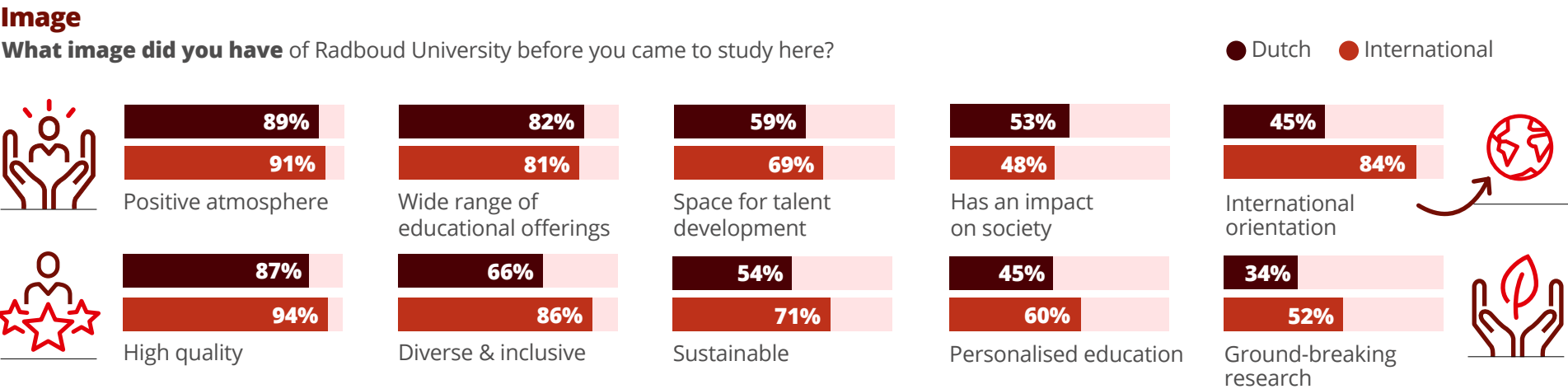
Percentage **first generation students** (both parents with no academic degree)

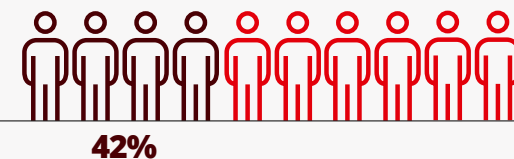
