RECIPES



How you use OER depends on your training vision and **didactic model**. Open educational resources are of great value for increasing flexibility.

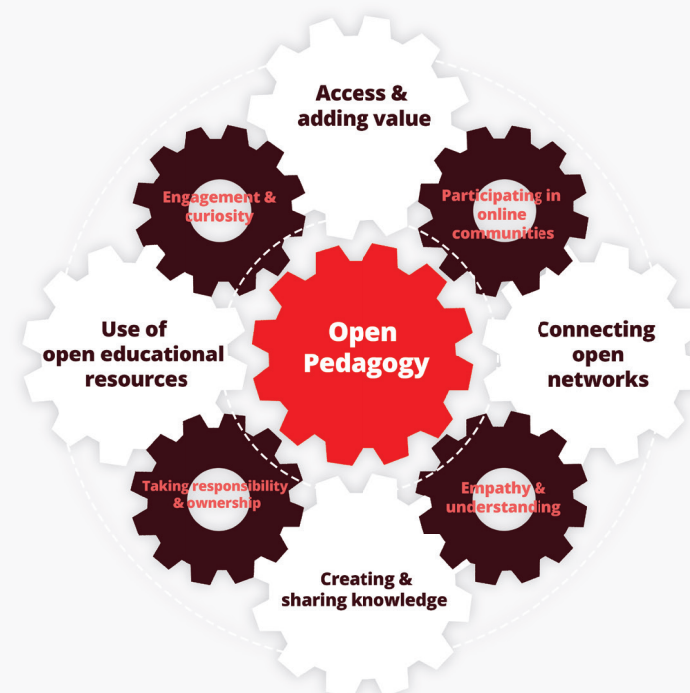
Here are a few examples you can get going with!

BASIC RECIPE

- ☐ The starting point for sharing and reusing OER is your personal **educational vision**, and the learning outcomes that need to be achieved.
- ☐ Lecturers can share, use and reuse OER with students, colleagues and professional communities.
- ☐ You can give students a role in creating or adding to (open) educational resources.

RECIPE START

- ☐ Lecturers make the course material accessible to students from the get-go.
- ☐ Students consult OER for **personal educational questions**.



RECIPE CHALLENGE

- ☐ Use training models in which an **issue or challenge** is the starting point for learning. These issues are authentic, complex and without a complete need for correct answers.
- ☐ Further information provided through students encountering questions along the way. They gain knowledge and skills that encourage problem-solving.
- ☐ As a lecturer (supervisor/expert), respond to the current demand for knowledge and skills by referring students to good educational resources. By using, reusing and sharing educational resources, there is no need to arrange resources for all students yourself.

DO-IT-YOURSELF RECIPE (OPEN PEDAGOGY)

- ☐ Get students to engage with the content actively by letting them **develop their own educational resources** using concepts from the knowledge base.
- ☐ Students immerse themselves, either based on interest or urgency and, by processing the knowledge, they translate what they learn into educational resources. For example: knowledge clips, blogs, articles (e.g. Wikipedia) and presentations.
- ☐ Engage in critical dialogue by examining the designed materials with fellow students and lecturers.
- ☐ Share good quality resources through tools (open source or otherwise) or platforms (e.g. github) for open educational resources, so they are accessible to other teachers and students, regardless of the stage of the study programme, allowing them to make best use of educational resources.



FLAVOUR ENHANCERS

Radboud-wide

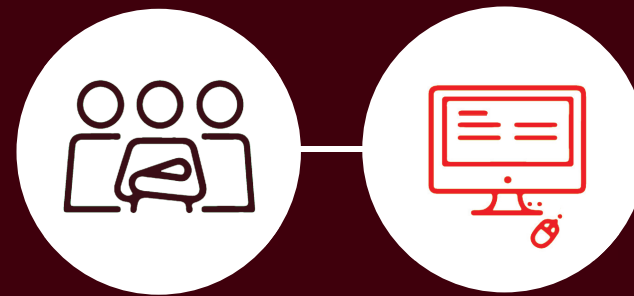
- Exchange and co-create knowledge between fellow institutions and/or professional communities.
- Good institutional reputation (both nationally and globally).
- Encourages innovation and experimentation.

For lecturers

- Saves time and money.

- Larger database of educational resources and ideas, such as through edusources.nl.
- Inspiring for other lecturers.

For students

- Provides a richer, more personal and inclusive learning environment.
- Easy, free and sustainable access to quality digital educational resources.
- Take ownership, including in choosing digital educational resources.
- Increases student engagement and activity.

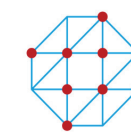
