Dear members,

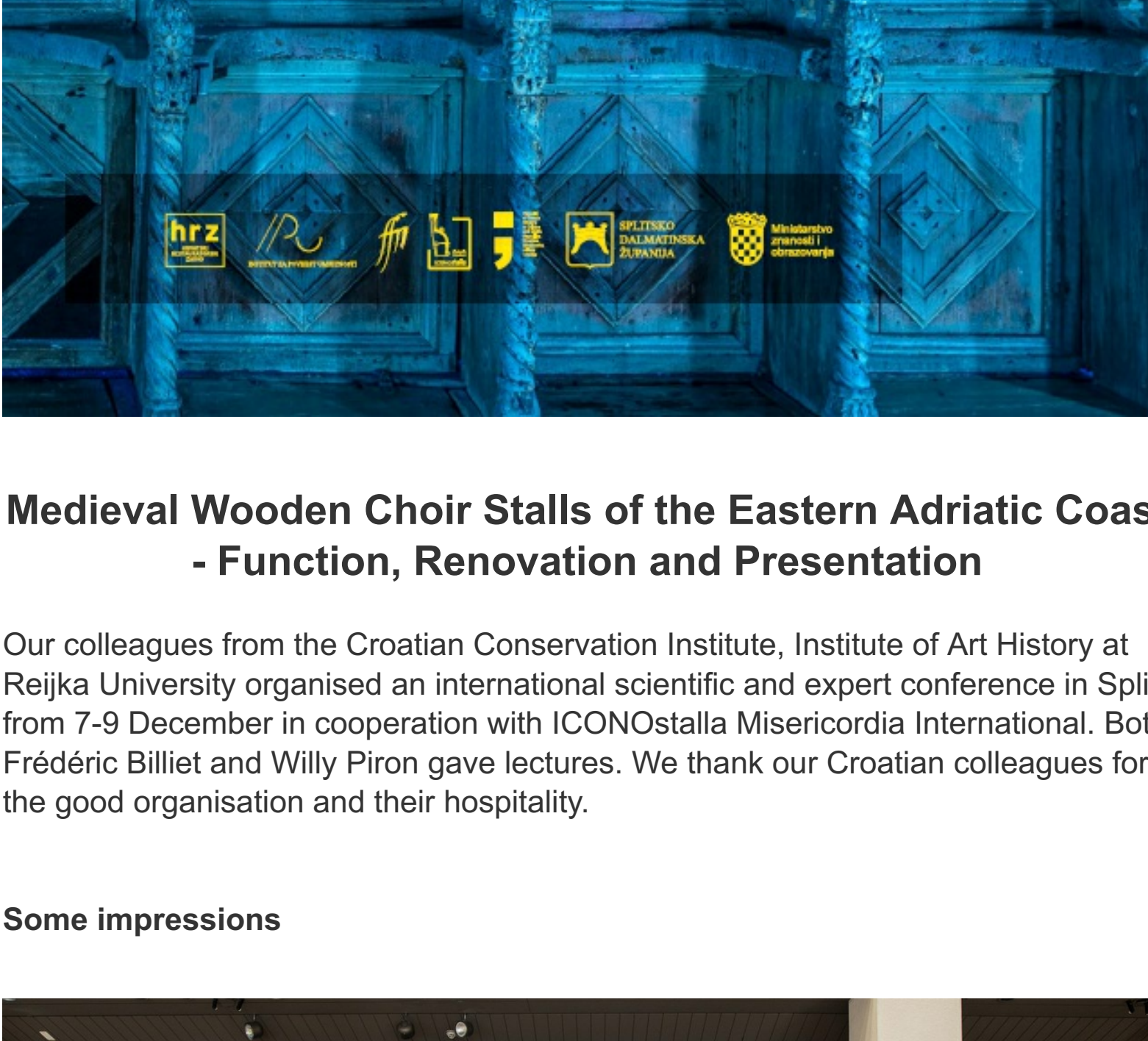

Anja Seliger published an article:

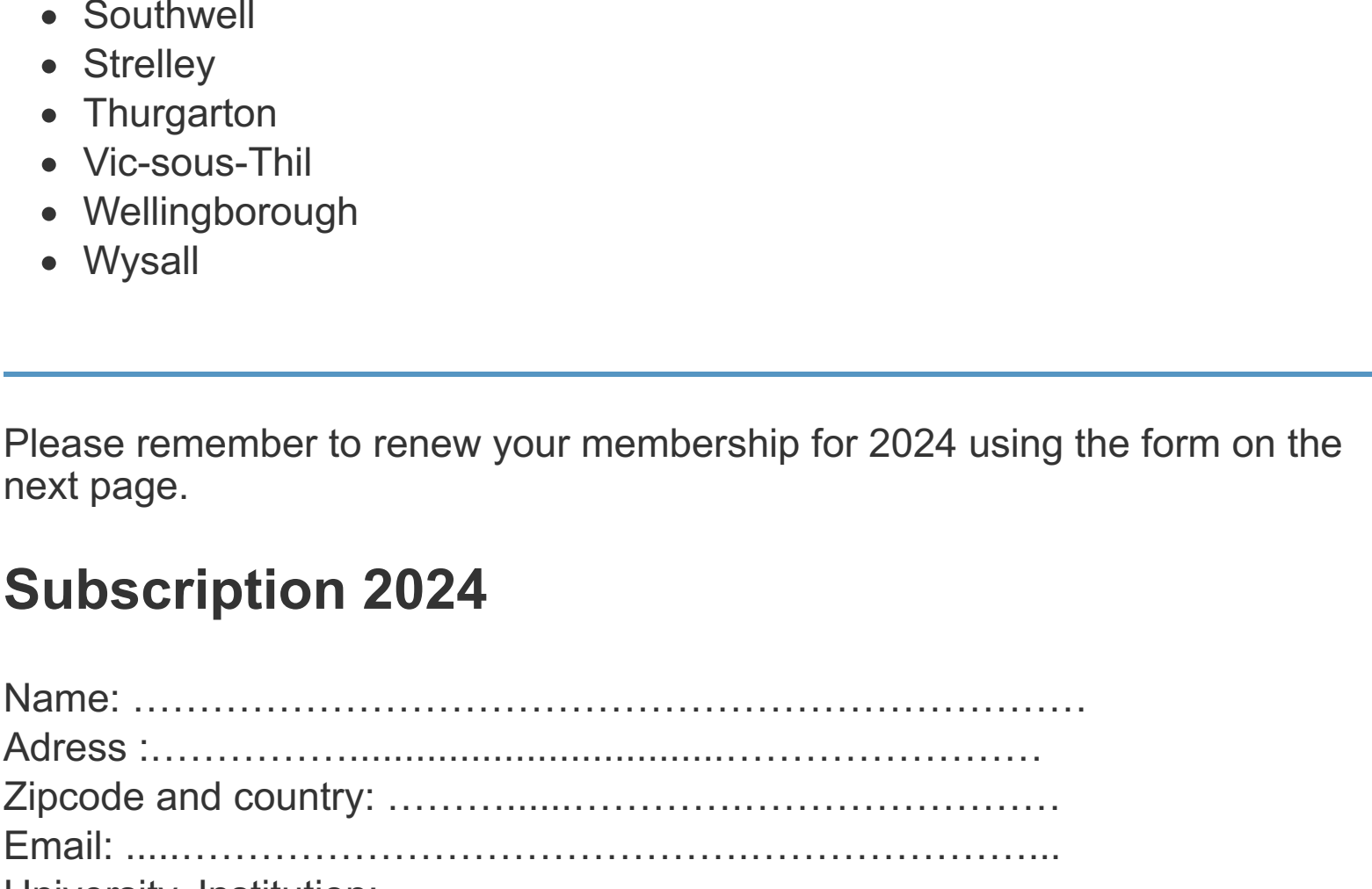
'Das Chorgestühl – Typisch Zisterziensisch?' In: *Cistercienser Chronik*, 130. Jahrgang, 20233, heft 3, p. 343-359.

The board of the Cistercian Chronik asked her to publish an article on choir stalls from Cistercian monasteries and nunneries. In 2013 and 2014, this topic was the focus of two papers, which she presented at EuCist (Europainstitut für Cistercienserforschung, winter school in Kloster Heiligenkreuz), and at a conference in Kloster Chorin (without proceedings). Her article in *Cistercienser Chronik* is slightly edited and reflects the research status of 2014.

Kristiane Lemé reported that the stalls from the abbey church of **Beaulieu-lès-Loches** have been restored and have been put back in the church.

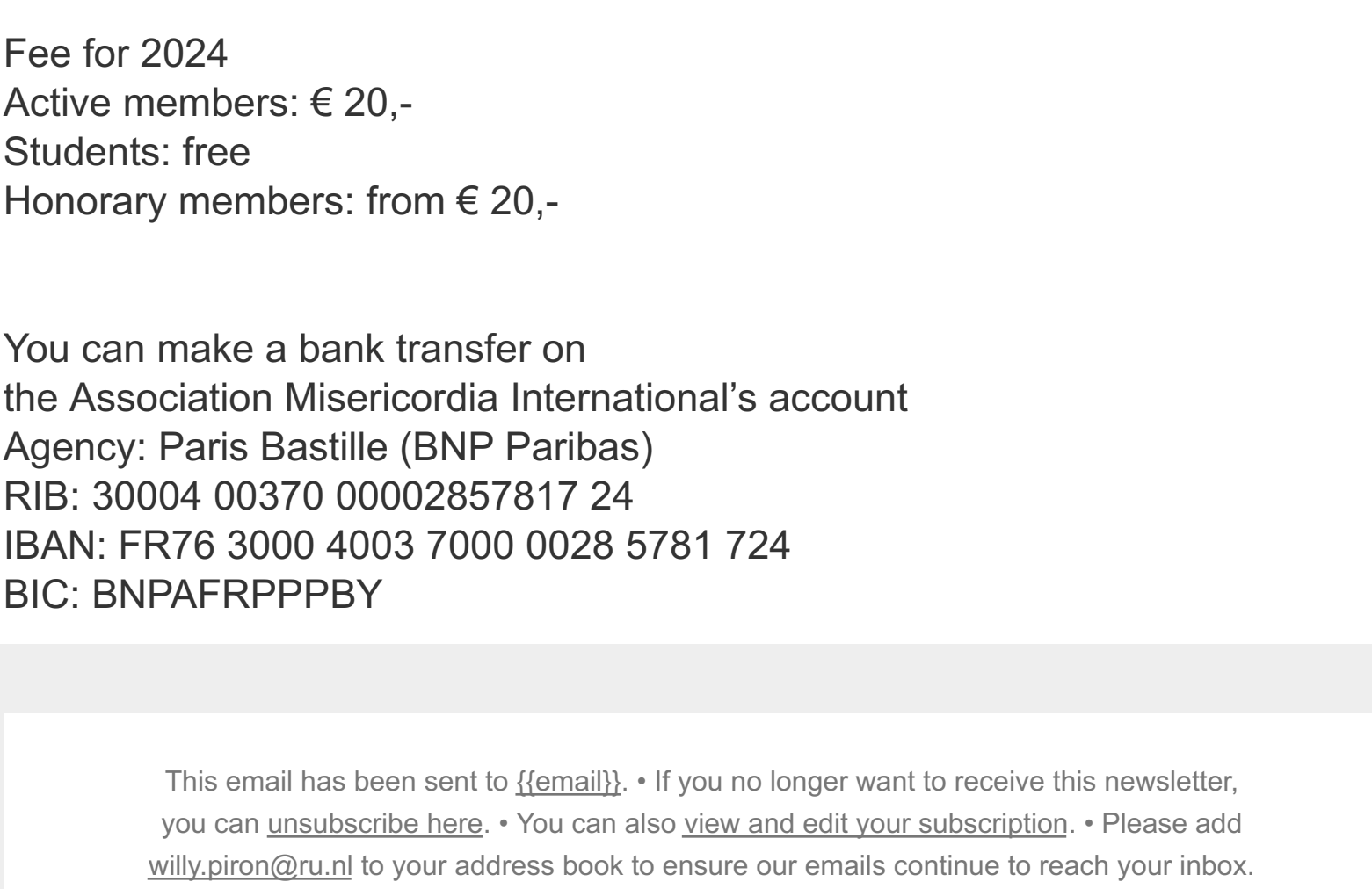
They will be inaugurated a week before Christmas.

The abbey's choir stalls and pulpit left the church in April. They were treated with "dynamic anoxia" (immersed in an enclosed space, without oxygen, to rid them of all insects). They were restored, stained and waxed by the Lemaire workshop (Parçay-Meslay). The pulpit was cleaned, reinforced and "restored to its original polychrome". The cost of the work was € 80,000, financed by the municipality, the state (through the DRAC of the Centre Val-de-Loire region), the Conseil départemental and donors through the Fondation du Patrimoine.
